1 Introduction

This document describes the initial configuration of QGrip and has been split in 2 sections.

Required

The required configuration must be done, otherwise QGrip will not work as it should. The configurations can be adjusted at any time. The required configuration is needed whenever a new AD-Domain has been added to QGrip. This happens the <u>first</u> time the Setup runs in a, for QGrip, new Domain:

- New First Domain
- New Secondary Domain

Optional

The optional configuration it not needed straight away. QGrip will run using default values or some functionality will be missing. The configuration can be added at any time.

Warnings

If you miss or forget parts of the required configuration, QGrip will issue warning that the configuration is NotActivated or Incomplete.

QGrip-UI

Initial Configuration of QGrip needs to be performed in the QGrip-UI. It is recommended that the QGrip-UI documents are reviewed prior to commencing configuration. You can start the QGrip.exe in the QGrip directory on one of the QGrip Servers. If it is the first time you use the QGrip-UI you will need to complete your personal details.

QGrip-Admin

In QGrip, the account that performs the Initial Configuration, needs to be QGrip-Admin. The user who performs the Setup is automatically added to the QGrip-Admin group. This user should also perform the Initial Configuration.

If, for some reason, the initial configuration has to be done with a different account, that account needs to be QGrip-Admin. Use the following document:







2.1.3 Access to QGrip






