

1 Maintenance Mode



If you know in advance, that certain parts of the QGrip configuration, will not be up-and-running because of Windows Patching, SQL patches etc. you should put them in maintenance mode.

- QGrip (System)
- QGrip Server(s)
- Instance(s)
- Backup Share(s)

The QGrip Maintenance Mode will prevent Jobs from starting for certain objects for a certain window (Begin/End time).

Already running jobs...Will finish (are <u>not</u> terminated)

Jobs that are already running when the Maintenance Mode window starts, will not be affected. The will run until finished and are not terminated.



To see which jobs are still running, use the QGrip UI.



When a QGrip Upgrade is installed, QGrip will put itself in Maintenance Mode during the Upgrade.

OGRIP

QGrip will arrange needed Maintenance Mode when Upgrade takes place, no action in advanced required.
