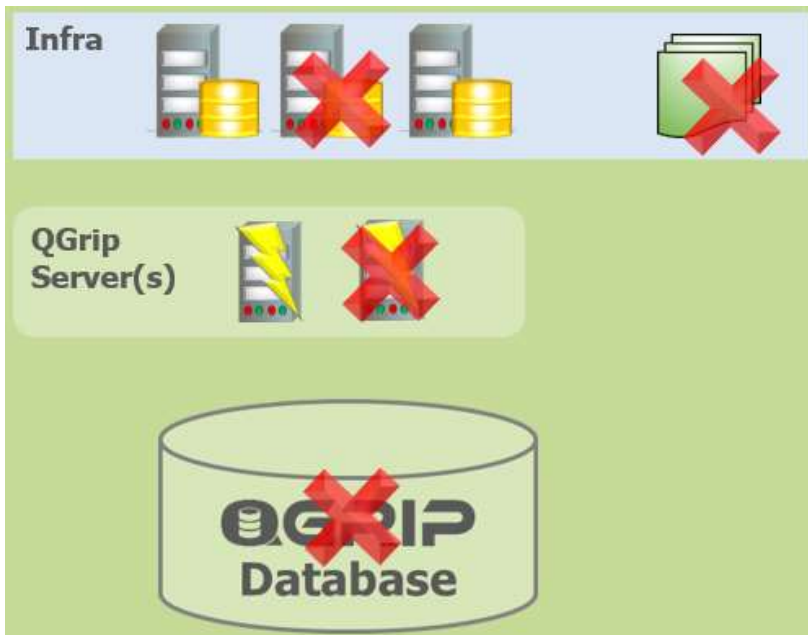

1 Maintenance Mode



If you know in advance, that certain parts of the QGrip configuration, will not be up-and-running because of Windows Patching, SQL patches etc. you should put them in maintenance mode.

- **QGrip (System)**
- **QGrip Server(s)**
- **Instance(s)**
- **Backup Share(s)**

The QGrip Maintenance Mode will prevent Jobs from starting for certain objects for a certain window (Begin/End time).

Already running jobs...

- **Will finish (are not terminated)**

Jobs that are already running when the Maintenance Mode window starts, will not be affected. They will run until finished and are not terminated.

QGrip UI

- **Jobs -> Running**

To see which jobs are still running, use the QGrip UI.

When a QGrip Upgrade is installed, QGrip will put itself in Maintenance Mode during the Upgrade.

QGrip will arrange needed Maintenance Mode when Upgrade takes place, no action in advanced required.
